EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 88-6

TRANSFERRING PROCUREMENT AND RELATED ACTIVITIES OF THE GUAM MEMORIAL HOSPITAL AUTHORITY TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION GENERAL SERVICES AGENCY.

WHEREAS, procurement irregularities have been discovered at the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority and the integrity of the procurement process must be restored; and

WHEREAS, the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority Board of Trustees has adopted as temporary procurement regulations those used by the General Services Agency and issued pursuant to Title VII-A of the Government Code; and

WHEREAS, personnel at the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority are not experienced in procurement pursuant to Title VII-A of the Government Code and the regulations promulgated thereto; and

WHEREAS, the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority is in the process of procuring much needed medical equipment and many supplies and hereafter this procurement must be done in accordance with the law and acceptable practices.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JOSEPH F. ADA, Governor of the Territory of Guam, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Organic Act, do hereby order that effective immediately, all procurement and related activity including but not limited to purchasing, receiving, warehousing and controlling inventory of the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority be transferred to the Department of Administration General Services Agency.
