EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 89-19

DECLARING A PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY
AND AUTHORIZING USE OF OUTSTANDING
APPROPRIATIONS FOR EMERGENCY EXPENDITURE

WHEREAS, Section 6113 of the Government Code of Guam, as amended by Public Law 15-75:4, authorizes the Governor to use any part not exceeding Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000) of outstanding appropriations within the General Fund for expenses caused by civil defense, public safety or health emergencies; and

WHEREAS, the air conditioning system at the hospital has become inoperable; and

WHEREAS, to avoid public health problems the air conditioning system must be repaired as soon as possible and measures must be taken in the meantime to provide cooling for critical areas in the hospital; and


NOW, THEREFORE, I, FRANK F. BLAS, Acting Governor of Guam, by the authority vested in me by the Organic Act and the laws of Guam, do hereby declare that a public health emergency exists at the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority, and hereby order as follows:

1. The Director, Bureau of Budget and Management Research is authorized to expend the total amount of not more than Two Hundred and Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000) from outstanding appropriations within the General Fund for use by the above-mentioned agency for the cost of parts, air freight of parts, repair, personnel, equipment and supplies needed to operate the hospital consistent with the health and safety of the citizens of Guam.


2. The authorization for the certification, approval and expenditure of necessary funds shall be this Executive Order, subject only to the exhaustion of identified funds.

3. Emergency procurement may be resorted to for the purposes of this Order.
