EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 91-06

DECLARING A PUBLIC SAFETY EMERGENCY AND
AUTHORIZING USE OF OUTSTANDING APPROPRIATIONS
FOR EMERGENCY EXPENDITURE.

WHEREAS, 5 GCA Section 22402 authorizes the Governor to use any part not exceeding Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000) of outstanding appropriations within the General Fund for expenses needed for civil defense, public safety or health emergencies; and

WHEREAS, a recent study of Carlos L. Taitano Elementary School indicates that certain classrooms may be unsafe for the children and teachers; and


WHEREAS, as a result the school children have been removed from those classrooms for their safety; and

WHEREAS, the Departments of Public Works and Education have determined that the rooms are repairable;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JOSEPH F. ADA, Governor of Guam, by the authority vested in me by the Organic Act of Guam and the laws of Guam, do hereby declare that a public safety emergency exists and hereby order as follows:

1. The Director, Bureau of Budget and Management Research, shall expend no more than Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000) from outstanding appropriations within the General Fund for use by the Department of Education for the repair and renovation of classrooms at Carlos P. Taitano Elementary School in Sinajana.
2. The authorization for the certification, approval and expenditure of necessary funds shall be this Executive Order, subject only to the exhaustion of identified funds.
