EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 91-07

DECLARING A PUBLIC SAFETY EMERGENCY AND
AUTHORIZING USE OF OUTSTANDING APPROPRIATIONS
FOR EMERGENCY EXPENDITURE.

WHEREAS, 5 GCA Section 22402 authorizes the Governor to use any part not exceeding Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000) of outstanding appropriations within the General Fund for expenses needed for civil defense, public safety or health emergencies; and


WHEREAS, recently it has become apparent that the Rosario Detention Facility is too small to confine those persons who should be detained prior to trial or in protective custody; and

WHEREAS, it is possible to renovate Building "B" at the Department of Corrections for use temporarily as a detention facility and later as a corrections facility; and


NOW, THEREFORE, I, JOSEPH F. ADA, Governor of Guam, by the authority vested in me by the Organic Act of Guam and the laws of Guam, do hereby declare that a public safety emergency exists and hereby order as follows:

1. The Director, Bureau of Budget and Management Research, shall expend no more than Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000) from outstanding appropriations within the General Fund for use by the Department of Public Works for the repair and renovation of Building "B" at the Department of Corrections.
2. The authorization for the certification, approval and expenditure of necessary funds shall be this Executive Order, subject only to the exhaustion of identified funds.
