WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 91-24 established a Committee on the Americans with Disabilities Act; and


WHEREAS, the Americans with Disabilities Act mandates telecommunications relay services be available to hearing-impaired and speech-impaired individuals; and

WHEREAS, the Guam Telephone Authority is vital in the implementation of this legislation.


