EXECUTIVE ORDER 92-26

Declaring a Civil Defense Emergency and
Authorizing the Emergency Expenditure of
Funds for Debris Removal.

WHEREAS, on August 28, 1992 Typhoon Omar passed over the island of Guam causing widespread damage including the destruction of many structures, trees and other vegetation; and

WHEREAS, public assistance is required to remove debris from public roads, public parks and other areas;


WHEREAS, Section 6113 of the Government Code, as amended by Public Law 15-75, §4, authorizes the Governor to use any part not exceeding Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000) for expenses caused by civil defense, public safety or health emergencies;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JOSEPH F. ADA, Governor, by the authority vested in me by the Organic Act of Guam and the laws of Guam order that:


1. The Director of the Bureau of Budget and Management is authorized to expend not more than Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000) from outstanding appropriations within the General Fund for use by the Department of Parks and Recreation for debris clearance; and

2. The authorization for the certification, approval and expenditure of necessary funds shall be this Executive Order, subject only to the exhaustion of identified funds.
