EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 93-03


TEACHER CENTER SPECIAL FUND

- WHEREAS,** the Department of Education has opened the Teacher Center to assist teachers with professional development and preparation of teaching materials; and
- WHEREAS,** each teacher will be allocated some free materials, and after exhaustion of their free supplies will be charged a nominal fee for additional supplies and services; and
- WHEREAS,** fines for late return of books or lost books will be collected; and
- WHEREAS,** fines collected at the Teacher Center should be used for purchase of books, supplies and services for the Teacher Center; and
- WHEREAS,** 5 GCA Section 22108 authorizes the Governor, when he deems it necessary and proper, to create, establish and continue from service fees, special funds to be used in maintaining such activities of the Government of Guam.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JOSEPH F. ADA, Governor of Guam, by virtue of the authority vested in me by Section 6 of the Organic Act and 5 GCA Section 22108, do hereby order as follows:

1. There is hereby established a Teacher Center Revolving Fund within the cognizance of the Director, Department of Education or his designee.
2. Such fund shall be maintained separate and apart from any other funds of the Government of Guam, and independent records and accounts shall be maintained in connection therewith as prescribed by the Director, Department of Administration.
3. All fees and fines received from users of the Teacher Center shall be deposited in the Teacher Center Revolving Fund and used for purchase of supplies, books and services for the Teacher Center.
4. The Director of Education or his designee shall submit to the Director of Administration a monthly statement reflecting the financial conditions of said Revolving Fund.
5. The Director of Education or his designee shall determine and certify all disbursements from said Special Fund.
