EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 93-06

ESTABLISHING THE POLITICAL STATUS
EDUCATION COMMISSION REVOLVING FUND

WHEREAS, Public Law 20-99 established the Political Status Education Coordinating Commission with the mandate to, among other things, develop curricula and materials on Guam's political history studies; and

WHEREAS, the Commission is also mandated to generate income from the sales of any and all materials so developed; and


WHEREAS, Public Law 20-99 specifically states: "Income generated by the sale of the textbooks shall be returned to the Commission which shall establish a fund for future revisions of materials during the life of the Commission; and

WHEREAS, it is clear that such a fund is intended to support the Commission's continued production of textbooks and study materials, as well as revised editions in the future.


NOW, THEREFORE, I, JOSEPH F. ADA, Governor of the Territory of Guam, pursuant to the authority vested in me by the Organic Act of Guam, as amended, and 5 GCA §22108, hereby order:

1. There is created the "Political Status Education Coordinating Commission Revolving Fund";
2. All funds collected from the sale of Commission materials shall be deposited into said Fund;
3. Said Fund shall be administered and maintained by the Political Status Education Coordinating Commission and the Commission's Executive Director is designated as the approving official for disbursements;
4. A complete and accurate accounting of all monies and deposits paid into and withdrawn from such Fund shall be maintained by the Department of Administration;
5. Such accounting shall include and clearly identify the sources and amounts of all funds paid into or withdrawn from said Fund.
