EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 94-02

AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 93-15 TO CONTINUE
THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTION'S ADMINISTRATION
OF THE YOUTH CORRECTIONAL FACILITY.

WHEREAS, since November 9, 1993 the Department of Corrections has administered the Youth Correctional Facility pursuant to the provisions of Executive Order 93-15; and


WHEREAS, the Department of Corrections' administration of the Youth Correctional Facility has proved prudent; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 4 GCA §4117 the Civil Service Commission has approved the continued temporary assignment of some employees of the Department of Youth Affairs to the Department of Corrections;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, JOSEPH F. ADA, Governor of the Territory of Guam, pursuant to the authority vested in me by the Organic Act of Guam, as amended, hereby order that Paragraph 6 of Executive Order 93-15 is amended to read:

6. the Department of Corrections shall transfer to the Department of Youth Affairs administration of the Youth Correctional Facility no later than 240 days from the promulgation of this order.
