**EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 94-14**

**THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE STATEWIDE INDEPENDENT  
LIVING COUNCIL**

**WHEREAS,** under the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, as amended in 1992, as a condition of federal financial assistance under 29 U.S.C. §796 et seq., each state must establish a Statewide Independent Living Council (SILC); and

**WHEREAS,** the Council shall not be established as an entity within a state agency.

**NOW, THEREFORE, I FRANK F. BLAS, Acting Governor of the Territory of Guam, by the authority vested in me by the Organic Act, as amended, do hereby order:**

1. There is within the Territory of Guam a Statewide Independent Living Council;
2. The members of the SILC and their terms are as follows:

3. The duties of the SILC shall be as set forth in 29 U.S.C. §796 et seq., as amended from time to time; and

4. The SILC shall report to the Governor and shall coordinate activities with the State Rehabilitation Advisory Council, the Developmental Disabilities Planning Council and the Governor's Commission on Persons with Disabilities.
