EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 96-12

RELATIVE TO EXEMPTING CUSTOMS AND QUARANTINE AGENCY SUPERVISORY PERSONNEL AND CUSTOMS OFFICER SUPERVISORS FROM THE PROVISIONS OF EXECUTIVE ORDER 95-11 FOR THREE (3) MONTHS; AND EXEMPTING FIRST LINE SUPERVISORY PERSONNEL OF THE GUAM POWER AUTHORITY FROM THE PROVISIONS OF EXECUTIVE ORDER 95-11 AS AUTHORIZED.

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 96-10, effective on April 12, 1996, put into effect emergency rules and regulations for the Customs, Agriculture, and Quarantine Inspection Services fee; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 95-11, effective on April 21, 1995, prohibited all supervisory personnel and persons occupying positions listed in the attachment thereto from incurring overtime; and

WHEREAS, for the Customs and Quarantine Agency, presently a group of recruits is undergoing an educational program to qualify them for the position of customs officer, and these additional customs officers are needed for the increased visitors and additional duties relative to the Customs, Agriculture, and Quarantine Inspection Services fee; and

WHEREAS, for the Customs and Quarantine Agency, for the next Three (3) months, until the new customs officer recruits graduate, the present supervisory personnel in the Customs and Quarantine Agency will need to regularly work overtime to accommodate the increased work load of the Agency; and

WHEREAS, for the Customs and Quarantine Agency, approximately Eight (8) supervisory personnel, including customs officers of the rank of Lieutenant and Major, will be required to work overtime on a daily basis during this interim time period; and

WHEREAS, for the Guam Power Authority, persons occupying the following first line supervisory positions, most of whom are working within the power plants or the transmission and distribution system, routinely respond, in addition to their normal working hours, to any and all emergencies and outage situations regarding the delivery of power to the people:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, CARL T. C. GUTIERREZ, Governor of Guam, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Organic Act do order:


1. For the Customs and Quarantine Agency, all employees who are either in supervisory positions or who occupy the position of Customs Officer Supervisor, as designated in Executive Order 95-11, who by that executive order are prohibited from being paid overtime, are hereby exempt from the provisions of Executive Order 95-11 for Three (3) months, from April 12, 1996 until the new customs officer recruits graduate and start work at the Customs and Quarantine Agency.
2. For the Guam Power Authority, and only when specifically authorized by the General Manager of the Guam Power Authority, employees occupying the above-listed positions in the above-listed Sections of the Guam Power Authority, who by Executive Order 95-11 are prohibited from being paid overtime, are hereby exempt from the provisions of Executive Order 95-11 from April 22, 1996.
